The Bank of Oklahoma Center is a multi-purpose convention facility with the capacity to accommodate concerts, hockey, arena football, NCAA tournaments, and other large public events. The 600,000 SF facility is an icon for the City of Tulsa, serving not only as a premiere events venue, but also as a destination in itself. The facility's design utilizes the sun's shine through the glass wall during the day, while being lit from within at night. The same glass wall wraps around the southern half of the arena to welcome visitors by creating a unique gathering space.
