West Palm City Center is at the heart of downtown West Palm Beach, Florida. This complex consists of a six-story city hall with a 65-foot capitol dome, a four-story museum, a five-story library with a vaulted ceiling that runs the full length of the building. There is also a five-story enclosed pre-cast parking garage. A 13,500-square-foot auditorium, with a 63-foot clear span, is on the ground floor of the city hall.

The structures for the city hall, museum and library, which total 250,000 square feet, are of conventionally reinforced two-way flat slab construction to achieve the maximum ceiling height, and still retain flexibility for future interior design and room arrangement changes.
