The new Student and Career Services Center is a two-story, 68,000-square-foot building which serves as the gateway to the San José City College campus. The building houses the campus bookstore, an enclosed loading dock, administration and counseling office space, commercial kitchen, inside and outside dining areas, campus security dispatch, media and conference rooms, a cyber café and the campus radio station and broadcast room.

The structural framing system is a special moment-resisting steel frame with a composite concrete floor, supported on a conventional spread footing foundation. The design of the building flows seamlessly from the interior to the exterior to connect with formal and informal gathering spaces.
